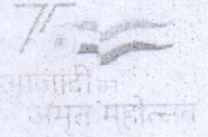



2. This year, the 20th August is falling on a Saturday which is a closed holiday for Central Government Offices and 19th August, 2022 too is a Gazetted holiday on account of Janamashtami festival. Therefore, in partial modification to the O.M. of even No. dated 11th August 2022, this year, the sadbhavana Pledge taking ceremony may be observed on 18th August, 2022.
