

Consequent upon notification of the revised SAS Rules 2019 circulated vide HQrs office Most Important Circular No.AN/SAS/16200/Restructuring/2019 dated 22.03.2019, the SAS Examination will now be conducted on Computer Based Test as per revised SAS Rules 2019.

2. As per Para 5(iii) of the ibid circular, MoD(Fin) have approved that after implementation/notification of Computer Based Test under new syllabus, if it is considered necessary at any stage, to provide any special chance to the pre-revised syllabus candidates, further SAS Part-II Examination(s) may be conducted. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Competent Authority to conduct a Special SAS Part-II Examination in the pre-revised syllabus in the month of June/ July 2023 for leftover candidates including 3 (three) SAS Apprentice who have qualified the SAS Part-I Examination in the pre-revised syllabus. The final schedule of the examination will be notified shortly.



With a view to familiarize the candidate for the process of appearing in Computer Based Test (CBT), few practice question of all the papers where candidates can practice answering the test question in the Computer Based Test (CBT) environment has been developed. The practice question for all the papers of SAS Part-I Examination (CBT) can be accessed with the link <https://assessment.examonline.in/MockTest/Mock/>. Candidate can click the said link and practice the question paper displayed as many time he/she wants.

2. The supported Browser to perform the Mock Test is "Google Chrome (latest version)" only. Before commencement of the exam (Mock Test) following System Compatibility Test which is required on the computer needs to be checked and verified:

Note: *1 Paper-III will not be shown in "BILINGUAL" format. The candidates are required to attempt the Paper-III in the opted language filled in their registration form as the MCQs of Section "A" are different in both the languages (Hindi and English). The descriptive question of Section "B" will appear on the margin of the computer screen which is slightly expendable. A candidate is required to type the answer in the space provided against each question in the language opted at the time of registration for the Paper. For English typing any font can be used. The size of the font for both Hindi and English typing may be in the range of 11 to 14.

Note: 2 The practice questions are meant for familiarization with the new pattern of examination only and are not indicative of the standard of the question.

4. Further the candidates are advised to note the following:-

PAPER-IV - Information Technology (Theory & Practical)

(i) The Theory portion of Paper-IV comprising MCQs will be similar to the MCQs of other papers.

(ii) For Practical Portion having questions regarding performing practical activity on computers, during the examination, the paper will be provided separately in the PDF format (with password protected) on the computer screen of the candidate. The requisite password to open the PDF file will be provided to all the candidates before commencement of the examination. The candidate is required to attempt the Practical Portion of the Paper as per following steps:-

(a) A candidate after attempting the MCQ may minimize the MCQ window preferably by pressing the keys "Window+D" without submitting the MCQ portion.

Or


(b) Candidate can submit the attempted MCQ and re-login the window with their credential. After submitting the MCQ portion, he/she can attempt Practical portion of Paper-IV. For attempting the practical portion, the PDF file

containing questions of Practical Portion can be accessed and after seeing the questions he/she can open the window of MS Word, MS Excel, MS Power Point, etc for performing the practical activity as per questions. A candidate can copy the question from PDF file to answer file.

- (iii) After attempting each question, the candidate is required to save the answers in three different files and name as Q-1, Q-2, Q-3 etc respectively for each question.
- (iv) After attempting both the portion of Paper-IV, candidates are advised to upload the files of practical portion and accordingly submit the same by pressing on submit button appearing on the screen.
- (v) The duration of 120 minutes for attempting the entire paper i.e. theory and practical portion needs to be taken into consideration.

5. It may be brought to notice of the candidates that instructions for each paper displayed on the screen may not be treated as final and are subject to minor changes, if any, as per requirements of CBT. A Run Manual to enable permission for webcam, microphone and location is enclosed for guidance as ANNEXURE "A".

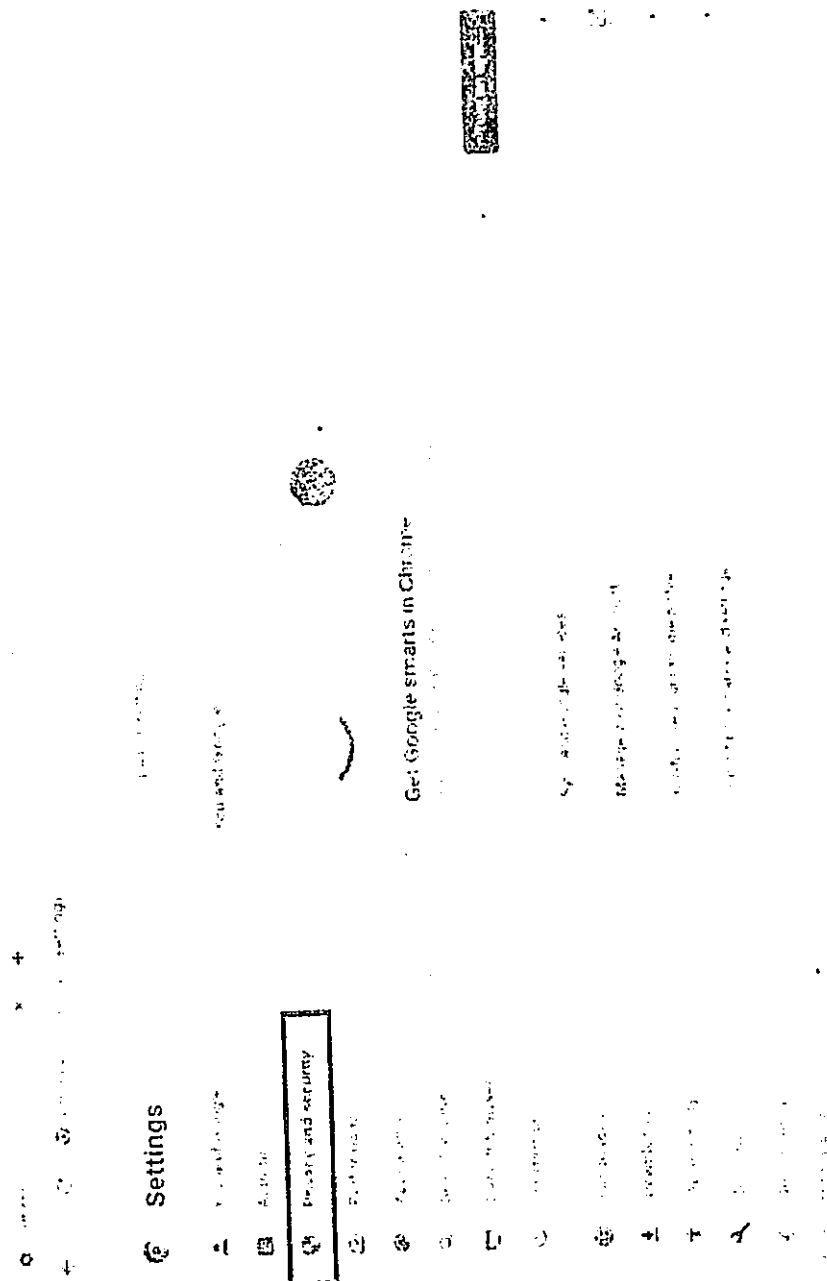


