Subject:-Electronic Bank Guarantee (e-BG) platform of National E-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) - Fast-Tracking Digital Document Execution (DDE) in banks.

Enclosed find a copy of MoF, Deptt. of Financial Services communication bearing No. F.No. 6/2/2019-BO-II dated 16.09.2022 vide which it has been informed that NeSL has developed a platform for issuance of electronic Bank- Guarantees (e-BGs) which is a specific use case of DDE platform. This platform allows banks to issue BGs in a paperless mode with digital stamping & signature where NeSL serves as a central repository. In such cases, NeSL provides notifications to the beneficiaries, direct access, verification & downloading capabilities. Accordingly, MDs & CEOs of all Scheduled banks have been advised to consider evaluating the benefits of the e-BG vis-à-vis adoption of the same in their banks.

- MoF has further highlighted that regarding the acceptance of e-BGs 3. in government transactions, Rule 170(i) & Rule 171(i) of GFR-2017 has also been amended vide their OM dated 05.05.2022. Therefore, permission/acceptance of the e-BG stands granted by MoF.
- It would be pertinent to point out here that Ministry of Defence & its subordinate organisations are also concluding a lot of contracts where-in to safeguard the interest of exchequer, the use of Bid security, ABG, PBG etc is quite mandatory. Therefore, it is opined that viability of eBGs needs to be looked into and adopted wherever found feasible.

This is to enclose herewith Letter No. NESL/ED/DDE/2021-22/663 dated 07.09.2022 from National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) on the captioned subject. NeSL has informed that it has now developed a platform for issuance of electronic Bank-Guarantees (e-BGs), which is a specific use case of the DDE platform. This platform allows BGs to be issued by banks in completely paperless mode with digital stamping and digital signature, where NeSL serves as a central repository, providing notifications to beneficiaries and facilitating direct access, verification and download capabilities. NeSL has also highlighted the advantages offered by the e-BG platform in the communication. They may be perused.

- 2. Regarding the acceptance of e-BG in Government, the Department of Expenditure (DoE), Ministry of Finance has recently notified amendments to Rule 170 (i) and Rule 171 (i) of the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017. Vide DoE's OM dated 05.08.2022 (copy enclosed), the acceptance of an e-BG as a Bid Security and Performance Security as part of the procurement process has been permitted.
- 3. In view of the above, you may kindly consider evaluating the benefits offered by e-BG and appropriately consider adoption of the same in your organization.

The NeSL DDE platform, which was launched in November, 2020, is now integrated with 26 banks/financial creditors and is enabled for digital stamping in 23 States/ Union Territories. Till date, more than 7 lakh transactions have been executed on this platform accounting for stamp duty amounting to Rs 32 crores. Details as of 31 August 2022 are indicated in Annexure 1.

We have now developed a platform referred to as electronic Bank Guarantee (eBG) which is a specific use case of the DDE platform. This platform allows BGs to be issued by banks in completely paperless mode with digital stamping and digital signature, where NeSL serves as a central repository, providing notifications to beneficiaries and facilitating direct access, verification and download capabilities. The IBA has shown keen interest in this initiative and provided valuable input by involving various banks during design of the process. HDFC Bank and ICICI Bank are already live and have started issuing eBG through NeSL. We are also working actively with a few other leading banks. NHAI has shown keen interest, as a beneficiary, in adopting this system and is in discussions with various banks. We are also happy to inform you that the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, has notified amendments to Rule 170(i) and 171(i) of the GFR, 2017 permitting the acceptance of e-Bank Guarantees as bid security and Performance Security (A copy is enclosed as annexure 2). This will enable the acceptance of e-BGs as part of the procurement process of all entities governed by the GFR, 2017, such as Central Government Departments, Organizations and specified bodies. The matter is under discussion with different state governments and one state government has expressed keen interest in integrating this platform with its Procurement portal.

The eBG platform offers several advantages such as better monitoring with triggers for renewal, less risk of forgery, faster procurement cycle, quicker encashment of BG. eBG, as a significant product on the DDE platform, can add immense value to the trade/business ecosystem in general by cutting down delays, bringing greater transparency, ease of verification and preventing frauds, and to the banks by enabling better customer service, enhancing efficiency,

Subject: Amendment in General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 - Acceptance of electronic Bank Guarantee (e-BG).

It has been decided to partially amend Rule 170(i) and Rule 171(i) of **General Financial Rules (GFR)**, 2017 regarding 'Bid Security and Performance Security respectively' as under:

Rule/ Para	Existing provision	Amended Rule
170(i)	The bid security may be accepted in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks or payment online in an acceptable form, safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects.	The bid security may be accepted in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (including e- Bank Guarantee) from any of the Commercial Banks or payment online in an acceptable form, safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects.
171(i)	Performance Security may be furnished in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt from a Commercial bank, Bank Guarantee from a Commercial bank or online payment in an acceptable form safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects.	Performance Security may be furnished in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt from a Commercial bank, Bank Guarantee (including e- Bank Guarantee) from a Commercial bank or online payment in an acceptable form safeguarding the purchaser's interest in all respects.
