Subject:-Clarification in respect of encashment of Earned Leave to reemployed pensioners- Reg.

* * * * * *

This Department has been receiving several references requesting for clarification, relating to CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972 regarding eligibility for leave encashment to Government servants who are re-employed after retirement.

- 2. In this regard, it is clarified that persons re-employed after retirement may be governed by rule 39(6)(a)(iii) of the said Rules and they may be granted leave encashment up to a maximum of 300 days including the period for which encashment was allowed at the time of retirement. The cases already decided otherwise in consultation with this Department need not be reopened.

Provision of Leave Rules in respect of Ex-servicemen working in DRDO

A point was raised in the Screening Committee meeting of JCM-III Level (DRDO) Council hold on 97 Dec 2015 at CFEES, Dent that a number of ex-servicemen have been employed in DRDO labs/cstablishments but they are not being allowed to avail leave encastment upto 360 days though their service in DRDO is counted as fresh appointment and as a result of this, the number of days of EL encashed by them in their past service is using deducted at the large of encashment on their retirement in the new/tresh service in DRDO.

2. The issue was taken up with DOPST through D(R&D) who have forwarded the following clarification on the matter

It is stated that any leave encasted by ex-senicemen at the time of their retirement from defence establishments may not be counted towards the total limit of three hundred days for leave encashment. They may be treated as having entered Government service for the first lime on the date of their re-employment as per Rule-34.

3. It is requested to bring the contents of this letter to the notice of all concerned. It is also requested to issue directions to the concerned officials to process the cases of exservicemen working in your labrestablishment eccordingly.
