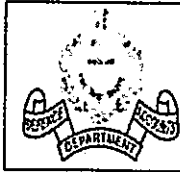

Subject - Clarification regarding admissibility of Night Duty Allowance to FED resigned to Station Officer.

Night Duty Allowance was admissible to the Fire Fighting staff as per list of categories identified for grant of NDA in accordance to the MoD OM dated 15.03.1990 (copy enclosed). It is pertinent to mention here that among the list of staff identified FED 'B' Fire Supervisors have been re-designated to the post of Station Officer with a revised pay level J and GP 2800 / -

Further, as per DoPT OM No. A-27016/02/2017-Estt (AL) dated 13.07.2020, the ceiling of Basic Pay for entitlement of NDA has been upgraded to Rs.43600/- per month.

Since, the list of categories has not been revised w.r.t admissibility of NDA to the Fire Fighting Staff who have been re-designated to the post of Station Officer, it is difficult to conclude whether Station Officer is eligible to get NDA or not.

In view of the above, your views and practice followed in r/o grant of Night Duty Allowance to fire fighting staff (FED 'B') re-designated to Station Officer may please be furnished to this office within 15 days for our better appreciation and enabling this office for further necessary action on the subject matter.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of Night Duty Allowance to civilian staff employed in Establishments under the Ministry of Defence.

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of grant of Night Duty Allowance to eligible categories of Defence Civilian employees other than those under the Department of Defence Production & Supplies has been under consideration of this Ministry for some time. Based on the recommendations of the Services Headquarters and in consultation with the Integrated Finance Division it has been decided that subject to the orders contained in Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 12012/4/80-Estt.(Allowances) dated 4.10.1989 which was circulated vide Ministry of Defence I.D. of even number dated 12.10.1989, Night Duty Allowance may be granted to the categories of employees mentioned in Annexure to this O.M.

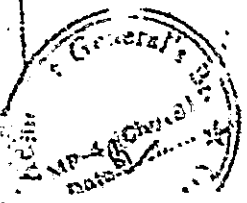
2. All categories of employees (except Nurses) who are at present getting Night Duty Allowance as per existing orders in Ordnance Factories, Ordnance Equipment Factories and DGQA Orgn. will be eligible to get this benefit as per above mentioned DPT orders dated 4.10.1989.

3. No Night Duty Allowance may be granted where night duty is an inseparable characteristic of the job itself e.g. Nurses and Sister-in-Charge of the hospitals.

4. The categories of employees not mentioned in Annexure to this O.M. will not be eligible for Night Duty Allowance. However, there may be some stray cases where staff is put on night duty. In such stray cases specific approval of an authority, one level higher than the authority competent to sanction Night Duty Allowance, may be obtained before sanction of NDA. However, it is reiterated that this should not become a general practice.

5. However, wherever OTA is payable, NDA will not be paid for the same period.

6. Under the above mentioned DPT orders, computation and payment of Night Duty Allowance is to be made w.e.f. 1.1.1986. In some cases, arrears may have to be admitted. While sanctioning such arrears the Head of the Office/ Authority competent to sanction Night Duty Allowance shall satisfy himself, on the basis of relevant records maintained and produced, that the individual concerned had actually performed night duty and was entitled to Night Duty Allowance in the light of the above mentioned



to the payment of Night Duty Allowance with the subject
to the availability of funds under the Head Allowances.
In case additional funds are needed, the demand may be
projected and payment may be made only after the requisite
funds are made available.

8. These orders will come into force with effect from
1.1.1986.

New Delhi, the 28th October, 2011

S.R.O. 68.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Defence Research and Development Organisation, Ministry of Defence, Group 'C' and Group 'D' (Fire Services) Posts, Recruitment Rules, 1998 as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of Recruitment to the Group 'C' (Fire Service) posts in the Defence Research and Development Organisation, Ministry of Defence namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Defence, Defence Research and Development Organisation Group 'C' (Fire Service) posts Recruitment Rules, 2011.

(i) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Initial Constitution.—The incumbents of the following posts in the Defence Research and Development Organisation at the commencement of these rules shall be re-designated as indicated below:—

(i)	(a)	Fire Master	Station Officer
	(b)	Fire Supervisor	
(ii)	(a)	Senior Fireman 'B'	Leading Fireman
	(b)	Senior Fireman 'A'	
(iii)		Fireman	Fireman

3. Number of posts, classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay, Pay Scale.—The number of said post, its classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay, Scale of Pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (1) to (4) of the Schedule annexed herewith.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.—(i) The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule aforesaid.

(ii) For the purpose of promotion, the Laboratories and Establishments of Defence Research and Development Organisation have been grouped into various Departmental Promotion Committee (I) Groups, as per the orders issued by the Government from time to time. Each such Group shall be considered as a separate and independent unit and promotion of eligible employees to the next higher post included in these rules along with the posts of Fireman and Leading Fireman. After the implementation of 6th CPC recommendations Group 'D' posts have been abolished and hence there shall not be Departmental Promotion Committee (II) constituted.

5. Disqualifications.—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
